



CV UNITED SOFTBALL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

CV United Softball is committed to providing a program that allows every child to play softball. We offer a limited number of scholarships each season (Spring, Select, All-Stars, Fall, Burbank) based on the league's financial health, sponsorships received from the community, and number of registered players. Applications are reviewed and approved by the CV United Softball Board and will be kept completely confidential.

The amount of scholarship awarded (if any) may be partial or full depending on the number of applicants and the amount of scholarship funds available for the season. Scholarships are awarded one per registrant, and expire at the end of the season. Requests for scholarships must be made for each season and applicants must meet the eligibility requirements. CV United Softball is a non-profit organization with a limited amount of funding available for scholarships. All applicants must meet certain financial criteria in order to qualify. Applicants may be asked to provide additional information to prove the player is eligible for the scholarship. Please do not ask for a scholarship if you have the ability to pay. If the applicant participates in any type of travel softball team or is taking private softball lessons, they are not eligible for a scholarship. However, we do understand that due to unforeseen circumstances finances may change and therefore depending on the circumstances a scholarship may be awarded.

It is recommended that you apply for the scholarship before the start of the season as scholarships for each season are provided on a first come and funding basis.

Requirements of eligibility:

- Proof of player's age (birth certificate); Player must be 14 or younger
- Player must attend a minimum of 90% of practices and games
- An explanation of why you are requesting a scholarship
- An adult family member must pay back the league through volunteering and/or obtaining a sponsorship for the league
- If applicable, documentation demonstrating an immediate financial hardship e.g., medical, unemployment, current tax return
- If applicable, proof of current participation in an assistance program such as, food stamps, SSI, Foster Care
- Application must be filled out completely by a parent, head of household or guardian; Incomplete applications will not be considered
